



DESIGN 21 and UNESCO also thank D21 Advisory Board members Marcella Echavarria and Indrasen Vencatachellum for lending their time and expertise to reviewing the entries, selecting finalists and their individual Judge's Picks.

Judges' Pick: colored lines by Marilena Florio (Italy) was selected by Marcella Echavarria as his Judge's Pick.

Marcella chose this entry because: It is simple, refined, and expresses the hand in a non-cliche manner. I like the colors and i think it has great potential for different applications on paper, fabric, online and video. This logo is simple, sharp and clear.

Marilena said this about her entry: the hands are an extension of our brain and our heart, they translate our thoughts, dreams, visions become reality. the hands as a unesco world heritage. with "colored lines" I wanted to represent the invisible power inside handicrafts creations. the white space has a lot of power to balance the lines and at the same time we can see the invisible hand. under the symbol, the font form a cuff. the lines look like a sparkling crown or a sparkling idea.five colors remind peace.
